1Co 13:5 Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;
1Co 13:6 Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth;
1Co 13:7 Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.
1Co 13:8 Charity never faileth:

We will *never fail* with this kind of love guiding our thoughts, motives, and actions. The qualities mentioned here are a description of the fruit of the spirit called "love" (Gal 5:22). Did you know that the fruit of the spirit are resident in you as a believer. They are a part of your spiritual "DNA". Love, this God kind of love, does not originate from you, but from Jesus.
