Good evening everyone,

Psa 133:1 A Song of degrees of David. Behold, how good and how pleasant *it is* for brethren to dwell together in unity!

Psa 133:2 *It is* like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, *even* Aaron's beard: that went down to the skirts of his garments;

Psa 133:3 As the dew of Hermon, *and as the dew* that descended upon the mountains of Zion: for there the LORD commanded the blessing, *even* life for evermore.

Today is the last in our series of the Psalms of Ascension. It is very fitting to end on Psalm 133. The theme of this Psalm is "unity among brethren". Could we say that this is the 'highest point' in our journey down here? The description of such unity is "good and pleasant"

When comparing this passage with the "fruits" of the "wisdom that is from above" in James 3 we can see similarities.

Jas 3:17 But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, *and* easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.

Jas 3:18 And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace.

I try to gage my life, attitude, and conduct by this scripture in James. If I see myself not reflecting these qualities I know its time to "make an adjustment". We want to live on the blessing side. We don't want to get over into bitter living. How about this..."Let's stay under the spout, where the glory pours out!"
