Tonight at our Wednesday Night family night, I spoke on the subject, He gives seed to the sower.

2Co 9:10 Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for *your* food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness;)

I told the story of how I was at church one afternoon, praying on the carpet in the altar area. I had gotten to a situation that seemed to have no answer. One of those times where I could not figure out a solution. I had been eating a tangerine or something and somehow one of the seeds was in my pocket. I put that little seed on the carpet and just looked at it a while.

There is such "power" in one little dry seed. It can make a huge plant with large quantities of fruit. Its really miraculous.

God always provides a seed for us to sow. He gives "seed to the sower". Many times we feel we've reached the end of things, then the Lord opens our eyes to the seed he has placed in our hand.

For Moses it was, "Stretch forth your rod". For the widow of Zarepath it was the prophet's command, "Bake me a little cake first". At the marriage of Cana it was, "fill the water pots with water". If we can just do that "one more thing", it can become our seed that will turn things in the right direction in our lives. In the natural sometimes we feel we've just run out- of love, strength, motivation, or other resources. At these times God will give us a seed.

As I was laying on that carpet in the church and looking at that little seed, it was like the Lord was saying to me, "You can plant a seed in this situation, there is something you can do". I had hoped for a little more of a "spectacular" answer to my prayer! As I understood what the Lord was saying to me, I was encouraged to know I could take one more step toward my miracle.

Are you facing something that looks impossible. Plant a seed in faith, and see what God will do.

Luk 17:5 And the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our faith.

Luk 17:6 And the Lord said, If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.
