Let's meditate on this thought today: "God loves me"

He loved us before we ever knew him

Joh 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believer in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

We were a part of that "world" that was lost. Ephesians 2:12 says we were, "without hope and without God in the world".

God loved us in this state we were in

Rom 5:6 For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.

Rom 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.
